Dear Madam/Sir,

In compliance with Basel Convention's requirements for activities related to the decommissioning of the FPSO Fluminense and its export for recycling abroad, Shell Brasil Petróleo LTDA, (hereinafter "SBPL") hereby presents this declaration of Removal from the hull of a former ship, FPSO FLUMINENSE, of possible sources of hazardous waste, as also stated by the IBAMA Interministerial Normative Instruction No. 2 (2016).

Article 2 of the Normative states: "the authorization request to IBAMA must be accompanied by a declaration by the party interested in the export that possible sources of hazardous waste were removed from the hull of the former ship as defined by the Basel Convention".

In view of these requirements, SBPL hereby presents the following points to IBAMA:

1. All efforts and best practices of the industry have been applied to remove the largest amounts of wastes (non-hazardous and hazardous), as practicable in an offshore environment, from the FPSO Fluminense prior to its shipment for recycling at destination country.
2. Due to the complexity of removal of residual naturally occurring radioactive material (NORM) found through radiological survey incrustated internally in piping, valves and equipment, SBPL confirms that the residual NORM from those systems will be properly removed during the dismantling and recycling scope of the FPSO at the MARS Europe shipyard, in Denmark, and properly treated for disposal at an approved final destination.
